Re: 19 Mile Road Improvements – Dequindre Road to Ryan Road

Dear Resident:

On August 17, 2021, City Council awarded a contract for the resurfacing of 19 Mile Road from Dequindre Road to Ryan Road to James P. Contracting Inc. The goal of the project is to replace the deteriorated asphalt travel lanes with new asphalt pavement. Additionally, this project will also improve the safety of the existing trail crossing on 19 Mile Road located east of Flis Drive via installation of pushbutton LED crosswalk flashing signage, warning ahead signs and crosswalk pavement markings. The project will be completed in two phases. Please refer to the project map on the reverse side of this letter.

Phase 1: Starting on September 7th (weather permitting), the contractor will begin by setting up traffic control devices and mobilizing equipment for construction of the south half of 19 Mile Road between Dequindre Road and Ryan Road. To enable construction, **only one-way, westbound 19 Mile Road traffic will be maintained between Dequindre Road and Ryan Road.** Detours will be posted for all eastbound 19 Mile Road traffic. The work within Phase 1 is anticipated to be completed by early October and will be open to traffic prior to commencement of Phase 2.

Phase 2: Upon completion of Phase 1 construction, the contractor will begin construction of the north half of 19 Mile Road between Dequindre Road and Ryan Road. To enable construction in this phase, **only one-way, eastbound 19 Mile Road traffic will be maintained between Dequindre Road to Ryan Road.** Detours will be posted for all westbound 19 Mile Road traffic. Work is expected to be completed by early November.
