APPLY FOR NO MORE THAN TWO

1. BAE Systems Scholarship – The Company will award two (2) \$1,000 scholarships to students pursuing undergraduate degrees in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and/or Mathematics curriculums). Candidates must have a minimum GPA of 3.5, be enrolled in a North American accredited university or college, be a full-time student and demonstrate involvement in extracurricular and community activities. Preference given to Sterling Heights residents.

2. General Dynamics Land Systems Scholarship – The Company will award four (4) \$1,000 scholarships to Sterling Heights area high school students pursuing an undergraduate degree in Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics. Candidates must have a GPA of at least 3.5, be enrolled as a full-time student in a North American accredited college and demonstrate involvement in extracurricular and community activities.

3. Macomb County Chiropractic Association – The Association will provide five (5) \$1,000 scholarships to students pursuing a career in chiropractic health care. Applicants may be enrolled in undergraduate studies with the intent of becoming a chiropractic physician and may already be enrolled in a chiropractic college. Applicants may also be high school seniors with intent to study the chiropractic field upon graduation. Open to Macomb County residents.

4. Mayor Richard J. Notte Scholarship for Government Public Service – The Sterling Heights Area Community Foundation will award one (1) \$1,000 scholarship to a Sterling Heights college student pursuing a career in government public service. Applications will be judged on academic achievement, financial need and community service.

5. Rotary Club of Sterling Heights Scholarship – The club will award two (2) \$1,000 scholarships to Sterling Heights residents who are either high school seniors or college students. Applicants must have a GPA of at least 3.5 and demonstrate community service involvement. The scholarship is open to students pursuing any field.

6. Selfridge ANG/Base Community Council Scholarship – The Council will award two (2) \$1,000 scholarships to children of military personnel attached to Selfridge Air National Guard Base attending college or vocational training. Applicants must be graduating seniors or college students with a GPA of at least 3.0 and be able to demonstrate strong community involvement.

7. Sterling Heights Community Foundation Scholarship – The Foundation will award three (3) \$1,000 scholarships to students pursuing college degrees or vocational training. This scholarship is for Sterling Heights area residents only.

8. Tom Kroll Scholarship – The Sterling Heights Area Community Foundation will award one (1) \$1,000 scholarship in honor of Tom Kroll, a retired UCS teacher and coach. UCS students only, must have a GPA of at least 3.0.
