

The Teen Room has been created for you. SHPR hopes that you enjoy the time that you spend here. In order for us to provide you with the best experience possible, we require that all participants follow these simple guidelines in order to ensure the safety and wellbeing of all attendees.

- Every participant must check in and out at the welcome desk every time he/she attends.
- Facility staff is not responsible for lost or stolen items, please leave valuables at home or store them in a locker.
- Appropriate dress is required.
- All problems or incidents must be reported to a staff member immediately.
- Disrespecting staff, peers, or equipment will not be tolerated, and will result in a dismissal from the Teen Room.
- Foul language, fighting, and gambling are prohibited.
- The possession or use of weapons, alcohol, drugs, and tobacco or vaping products are prohibited.
- Any harassment, including bullying, sexual harassment and verbal slurs involving race, ethnicity, disability, or sexual orientation will not be tolerated.
- Verbal or physical abuse of any kind will not be tolerated.
- Any personal video games/movies brought into the Teen Room must be approved by staff. No "M" rated video games or "R" rated movies.

Failure to follow these guidelines will result in the loss of Teen Room privileges, up to, and including suspension and removal from the Sterling Heights Parks and Recreation building.

1. A verbal warning is given to the participant in regards to their behavior.
2. Loss of activity time.
3. Conversation with the participant's parents. Depending on the severity of the situation, this can be done immediately.
4. Suspension and/or removal from the Community Center Teen Room.

By signing below I acknowledge that I have read, reviewed, and agree to follow all of the above guidelines. I hereby acknowledge I am responsible for my behavior, and that of my child/children, and agree that we will conduct ourselves in accordance with the Guidelines set forth herein. I understand that a violation of these rules could result in removal from the Community Center. I also acknowledge that Sterling Heights Parks and Recreation staff reserve the right to, in situations judged extreme, modify the steps/interventions outlined above in a manner in which they deem appropriate, and in the best interest of the safety of all parties involved.
