

2021 Spring/Fall Plant List Tree Choices

**Due to tree availability please note 1st choice and 2nd choices*

Fall choice cut off February 15th * Following Spring choice cut off August 15th

American Beech <i>Fagus grandifolia</i> (Spring Plant Only)	50-70 feet. Slow to medium growth rate. Bright green in spring and golden bronze in the fall. They have long branches that create a large, dense canopy.
Black Gum <i>Nyssa Sylvatica</i> <i>Catalpa speciosa</i>	30-40 feet. Slow growing. Dark green glossy leaves with scarlet red fall color. Dark, blocky bark and unique branching patterns provide winter interest. open structure. White flower clusters in spring.
Allee Elm <i>Ulmus parvifolia</i>	40-50 feet Upright, arching growth habit with green foliage. Highly resistant to Dutch Elm Disease & Elm Leaf Beetle.
Princeton Elm <i>Ulmus Americana</i>	50-60 feet. Dense, vase shaped growth habit with dark green leaves and yellow fall foliage. Dutch Elm Disease Tolerant.
Jefferson Elm [Improved Princeton Elm]	50-60 feet. Upright & vase-shaped, with green leaves that turn yellow in the fall. Dutch Elm Disease Tolerant.
American Hornbeam <i>Carpinus caroliniana</i>	20-25 feet. Dark green leaves turn yellow, to orange-red in fall. Oval in shape, and an Eastern U.S. Native tree.
European Hornbeam <i>Carpinus betulus</i>	30-35 feet. Dense tree with a columnar growth habit. Dark green leaves turn yellow in fall.
Kentucky Coffeetree <i>Gymnocladus dioica</i>	60-70 feet. Upright, vase shaped habit with green leaves. Extremely tolerant of adverse conditions.
Greenspire Linden <i>Tilia Cordata</i> (Spring Plant Only)	30-50 feet. Fast growing tree with pyramidal form. Green leaves in summer, turning to yellow in the fall.
Autumn Brilliance Serviceberry <i>Amelanchier x Grandiflora</i>	15-20 feet. White flower clusters in spring, green summer foliage and bright red fall color. Upright growth habit
Tulip Tree <i>Liriodendron</i>	50-60 feet. Uniquely shaped leaves that are medium green, turning to bright yellow in fall. Produces large, yellow flowers similar to that of a tulip, when it matures.
Serviceberry <i>Amelanchier Canadensis</i>	15-30 feet. Medium to dark leaves that change to orange-red in autumn. Slightly fragrant white flowers that give way to small green berries.
Red Bud <i>Cercis Canadensis</i>	20-30 feet. Heart shaped leaves 3-5 inches. Flowers are light to dark magenta pink.
Turkish Filbert <i>Corylus colurna</i>	Up to 60 ft tall. Will produce a type of hazel nut given off every 2-3 years. Shade tree with dark green foliage.
Amur Maackia <i>Maackia amurensis</i>	20-30 feet. Clusters of white pea like flowers appear in late spring. Small shade tree. Grows slow to moderate. Silver-gray leaves when unfolding turning dark green.
Japanese Lilac 'Ivory Silk-Amur Lilac'	Up to 30 ft. in height. White fragrant flowers bloom in early summer. Medium to dark green leaves.

Accolade Elm
Ulmus -Accolade

70 ft. Upright vase shape with arching branches. Dark green leaves in summer.
Yellow fall color.

Triumph Elm
Ulmus- Triumph

55 ft. tall. Upright oval to vase shape. Glossy dark green leaves yellow in fall.

Princeton Elm
Ulmus- PIONEER

50 ft. tall. Dark green leaves Yellow fall color

Frontier Elm
Ulmus hybrid

40 ft. tall. Vase to oval in shape. Glossy green leaves in summer with Burgundy fall color

Autumn Blaze
Acer x freemanii

50 ft. tall. Fast grower up to 3 ft. per year. Green leaves in summer turning yellow, red,
and orange in fall.
